However, the first author or person submitting an abstract(s) must register for the Conference/Symposium and be present during presentations and/or the poster session. Oral abstract presentations are tentatively scheduled for Wednesday afternoon, April 30, from 3:30-5:30 p.m. The poster session will be held on Wednesday evening, April 30, in conjunction with the Welcome and Poster Session Reception, 6-7 p.m.
